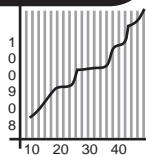

Tips & Tricks

Statistics - New Patients

You can use Optosys² to produce different statistics from your data.

Here's how to produce a report listing the number of new patients per optometrist, for 2005.

1. In the "Selection" menu select "Execute statistics..."
2. At step 1 "Source", simply click on "Next"
3. At step 2 "Details", click again on "Next"
4. At step 3 "Filter", select "File date" in the upper section and then click on "Next"
5. At step 4 "Dimension", select "Optometrist last name" in the upper section and then click on "Next"
6. At step 5 "Aggregate", select "Patient" in the upper section and then click on "Execute"
7. In the "Filter" window, select "Count" from the dropdown list, then click on "Add" and then on "OK" (which will return you to step 5)
8. Click on "Execute"
9. In the "Filter" window, enter "from" 2005-01-01 "to" 2005-12-31, click on "Add" and then on "OK"

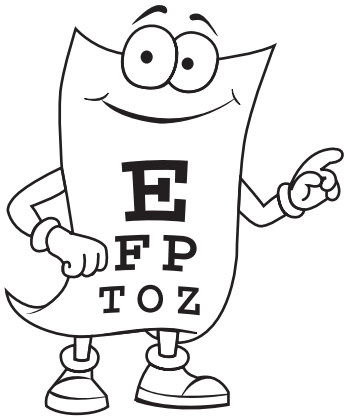
The result will appear under 3 tabs. The "Data" tab displays a table, the "Description" tab displays the parameters entered for the selection and the "Chart" tab displays a chart. The default setting in the last tab is a bar chart; however you can easily change it into a pie chart by using the buttons above the image.
