The evolution of data storage has gone from floppy disks to Zip readers to CDs to its current form: flash memory. The most common is found in the form of USB flash drives, also known as keys. Flash memory USB keys come in all sorts of weights, capacity, and data transfer speeds. There are so many on the market that it can be difficult to choose, so how do you decide which one is the best one for you?

Other than memory capacity, size, design, and colour, the principal difference between standard keys are the interface which can be 1.1 or 2.0. A 1.1 USB port allows data transfers at the maximum rate of 12 megabits per second while the 2.0 allows data transfers at 480 megabits per second – 40 times faster! However if your computer's USB port is 1.1, the data transfer will only be 12 megabits per second even if your key is a 2.0. The same is true if you plug a 1.1 key to a 2.0 computer port.

All USB modules introduced over the past years operate the same way. When plugged into a computer's USB port, they are automatically recognized by the computer if Windows 2000 or Windows XP is being used. A device driver, provided by the USB manufacturer, is required for Windows 98 SE. Unfortunately, the device driver doesn't always work.

As soon as the key is inserted, the computer's operating system recognizes the module as an external mass storage device similar to an external hard disk or a CD burner. This allows the user to transfer files between the computer and the USB key exactly as if it were being done from one hard disk to another or from one directory to another right on the computer itself. Transferring data is very easy to do. Once the transfer is completed, the key is simply removed from the USB port. It's now ready to go wherever you feel like taking it! 😊

How to order online using Optosys^{®2}

This article is the follow-up on last month's article on accessing products online.

Here's how to **send your order to the supplier** using the b2b.

1. In the **Spectacles** window, where you've already selected a pair of frames available on the b2b, click on the **Order** button at the bottom of the screen. (Reverse #1)
2. The **Order** window will appear. The default order quantity is set at 1, but you can modify it if required. (Reverse #2)
3. Click on **Save**. This will create the order in your system.
4. The order will appear on your screen. Click on the **Order** button to send it to the supplier. (Reverse #3)
5. A message confirming that the order was successfully created and transmitted will appear on your screen. (Reverse #4)

You must contact the supplier directly in order to cancel this order as it is already in his order box!
