[TIPS & TRICKS]

How to identify an RX that was given to a patient (“Walk Out”).

Here is an easy way to identify an Rx that you have given to a patient. The goal is to flag the patients that had an eye exam done but that did not purchase any products in your clinic (“Walk Out”).

[1.] In the patient’s spectacle prescription, in the **Ophthalmic Lens section**, select **“RX Given”** from the **“Use”** drop down list. If this description does not exist, click on the **“+”** to create it. Once it is created, it will remain available in the drop list for future use.
